Thank you to all our families who joined us yesterday for crafts and a picnic to celebrate VE Day - what a lovely afternoon it was!

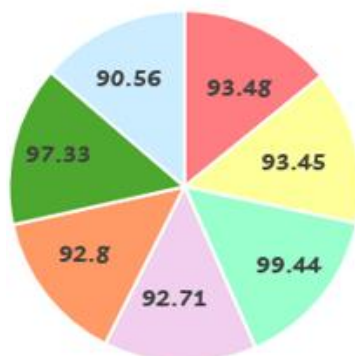
