Happy half term to all our families! We hope you have a lovely week together.

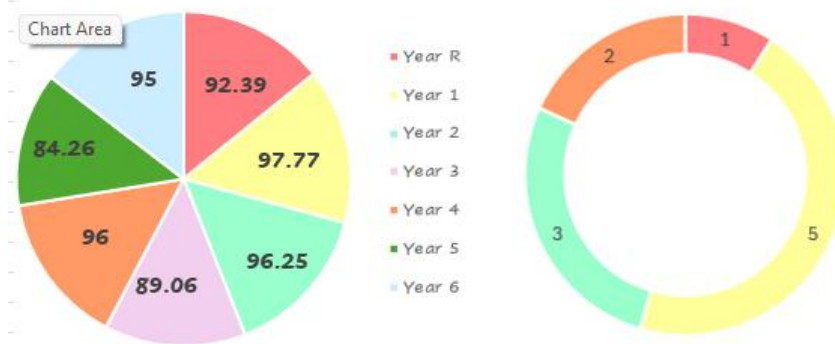
School will re-open on Tuesday 3rd June. Next half term, we have so much to look forward to in school. Please keep an eye on the diary dates.
