Well done Year 3!

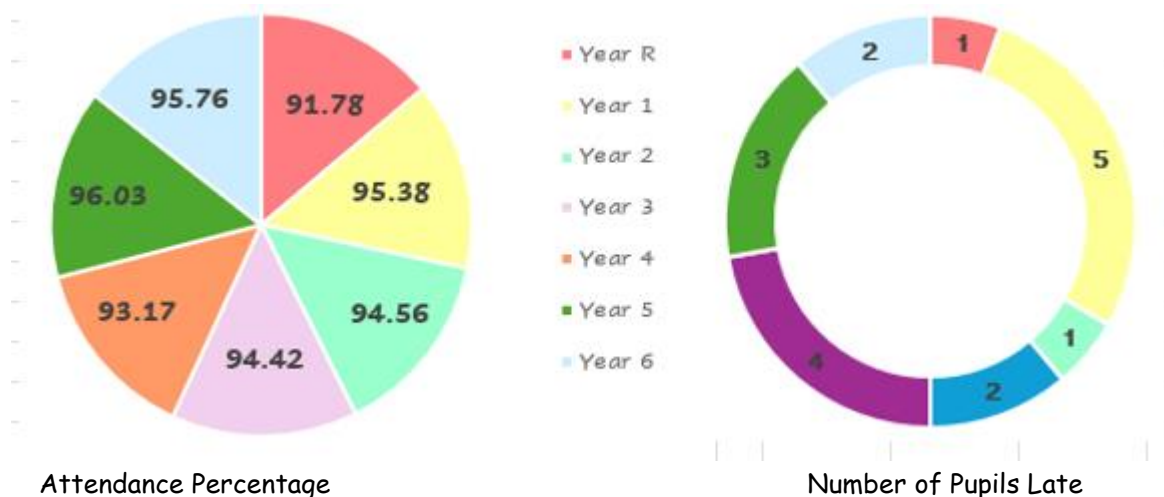
Most of our Year 6 children visited their new high schools also, and I'm sure came back to school just a little bit taller! It has been great to hear them chatting excitedly about next year.
