We still have lots to look forward to with our Buckfest festival on Monday, Year 6's end of year production, the pre-school graduation and end of year awards.

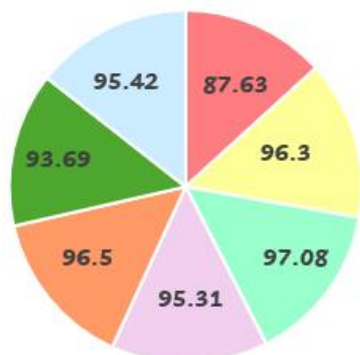

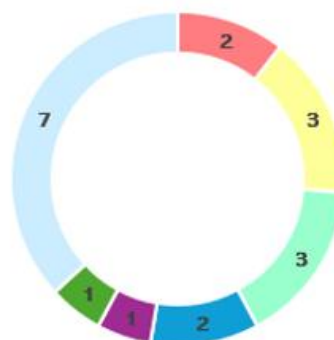
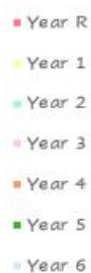

Our overall attendance this week is **94.75**

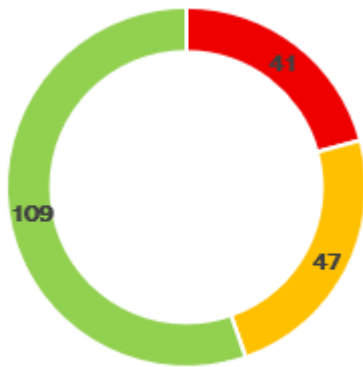


Attendance Percentage
