Dear Parents & Carers

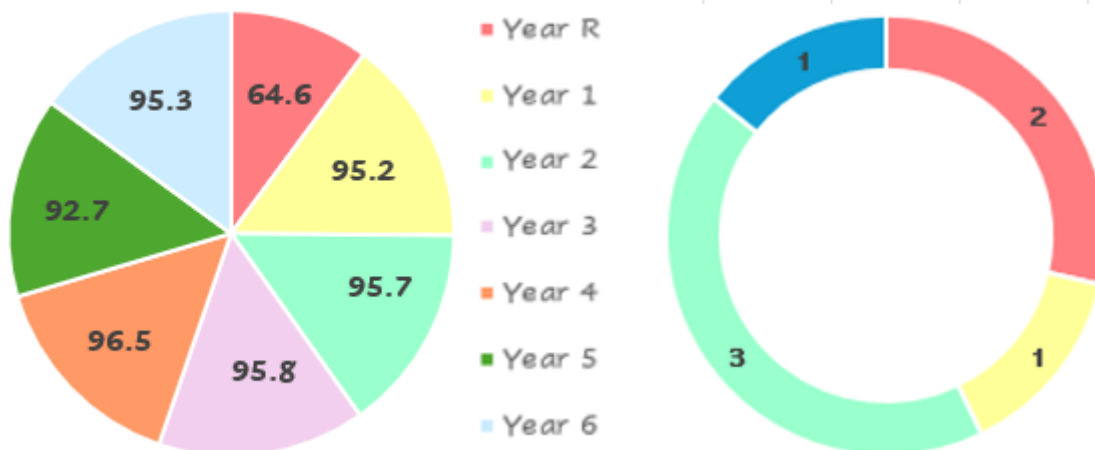

Alder Hey have saved our girl's life on numerous and will be forever thankful for all they do for her. Taking part in the Pyjama campaign has been an absolute privilege as if it means we can raise funds for them, and give back just a little of what they have given to us!'
