Dear Parents & Carers

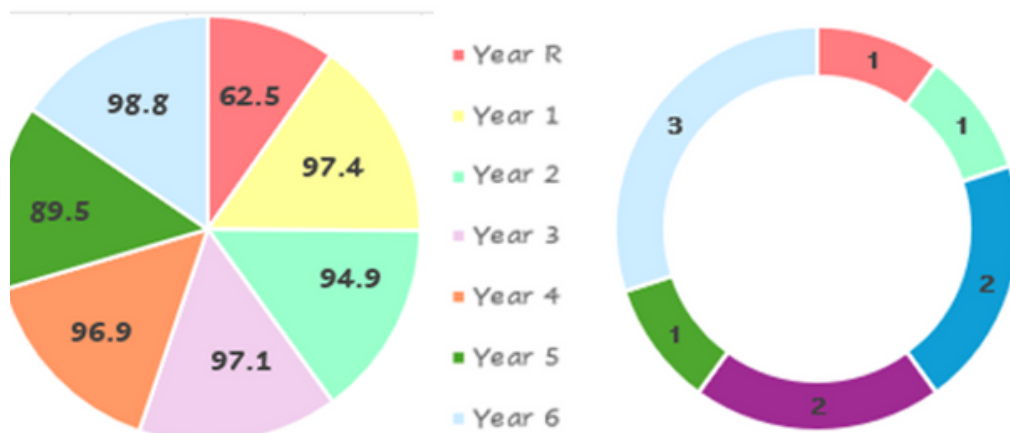

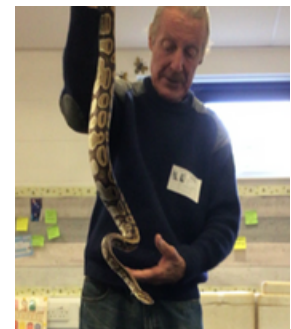
