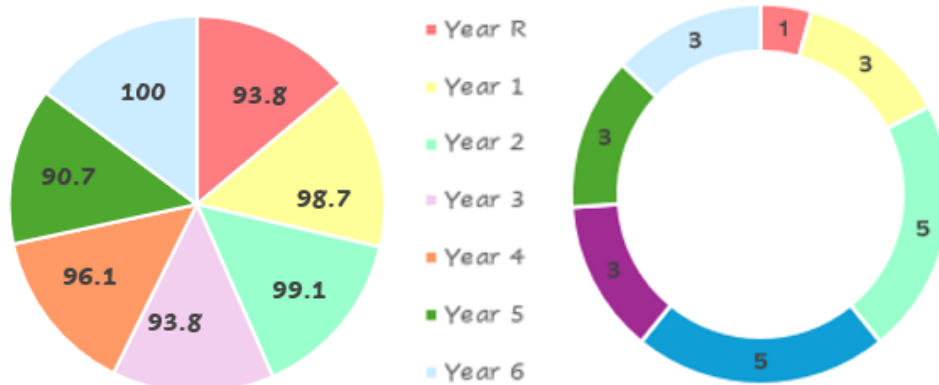

New School Roof

As you may be aware, we have been experiencing some issues with leaks from our roof in various places throughout school. This has been investigated over the past year and as a result, we are lucky enough to have been successful in securing funding from Lancashire County Council for a brand new roof!

Whilst this is great news and we can't wait for the roof to be complete, this is a huge project! Over the half term break, the contractors will be moving onto the school grounds to set up a huge amount of scaffolding all the way around the school building and this will remain in place until the roof is complete in approximately 6 months time.

This project is going to cause some unavoidable disruption to routines and spaces in school. Each class will spend some time over the next few months using the hall as a classroom whilst their classroom roof is worked on. This will have an impact on things like dinners, assemblies and so on. We will keep communicating via the School App and Class Dojo to keep you aware of any changes, but please bear with us at this time.
