Have a lovely weekend.

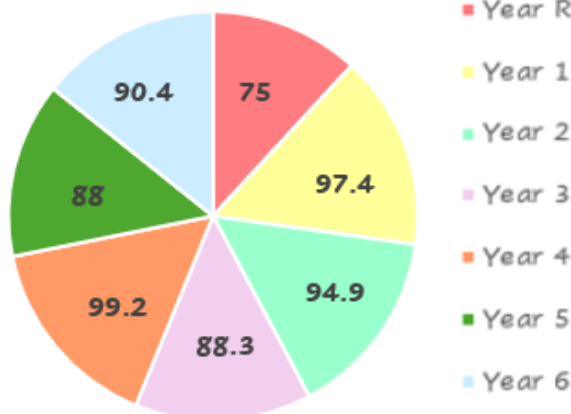

LATE ARRIVALS AND NON-ATTENDANCE

Reception Nativity

Tickets for Reception's nativity, 'Hushaby Nativity' are available on ScoPay. There are two performances - one at 10am on Tuesday 9th December and another at 2pm on Wednesday 10th December.

Due to it being only one class performing, there are plenty of tickets and no restrictions on numbers, so grandparents, aunties, uncles etc are all very welcome.

Tickets cost £1 each which helps us to cover the costs of costumes, scripts and licensing. Nearer the time, the tickets will be sent home with your child.

Year 1 and Year 2 Christmas Show
