The coaches are expected to return to school at approximately 4.15pm.

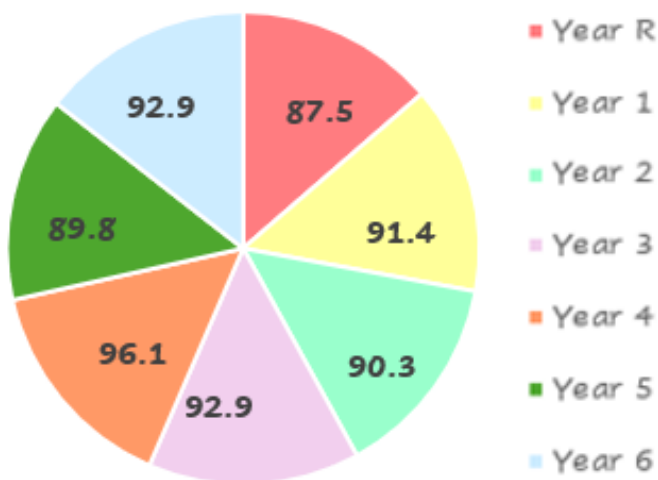
