Wishing all our families a very happy Christmas and an enjoyable break. We look forward to 2026 and all the things we have to look forward to next term!

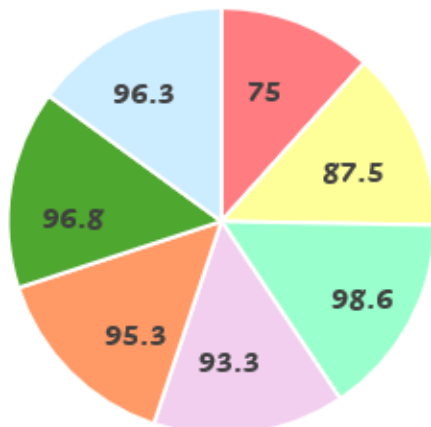

ATTENDANCE PERCENTAGE AND LATES OUR OVERALL ATTENDANCE THIS WEEK IS 92.4%

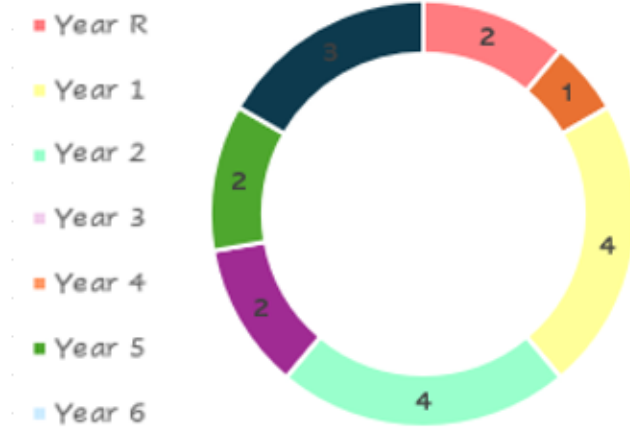
This weeks attendance winners are Year 4.
