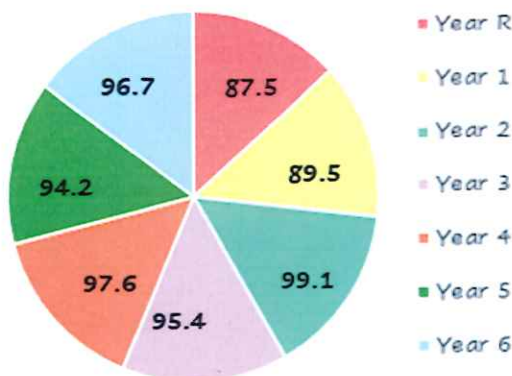
We have lots of exciting events coming up in school which are added to the calendar further down this letter. Details of events will be published nearer to the time.
