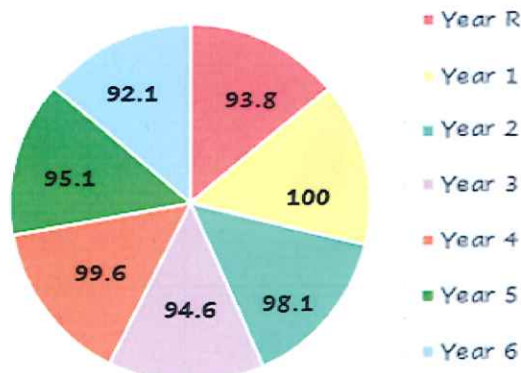
Next Friday we will be holding a 'Break the Rules Day' to raise money for school funds. We look forward to seeing the children have lots of fun with this theme!

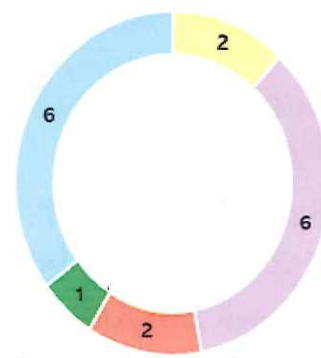
ATTENDANCE PERCENTAGE AND LATES OUR OVERALL ATTENDANCE THIS WEEK IS 96.2%
