This week I have spent some time in classes looking at children's learning in English and Science which was a joy to see. The vocabulary children were using whilst being scientists was incredible!

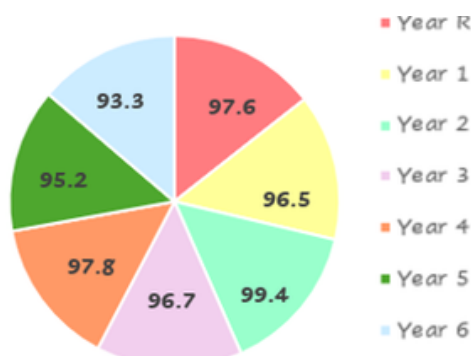
