Today was a very exciting day for our Reception children who had their very first school trip to Blackpool Zoo! The children had a wonderful time and represented our school brilliantly!

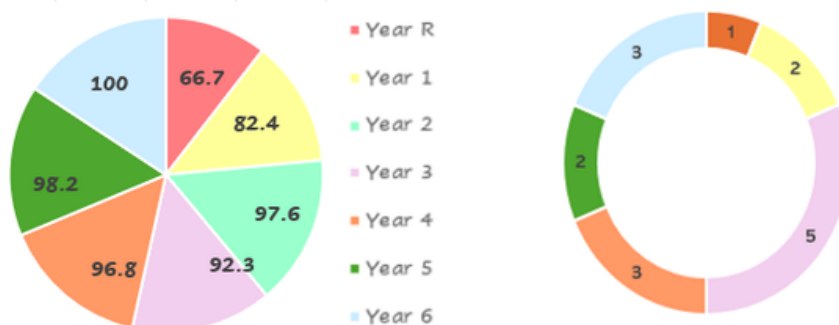
I would like to extend a big thank you to all the staff and volunteers involved in these trips, particularly those who stayed overnight, away from their own families - the children could not have these experiences without your support.
