I would also like to thank the team of staff who accompanied these trips, but also back at school, who made these experiences happen for our children.

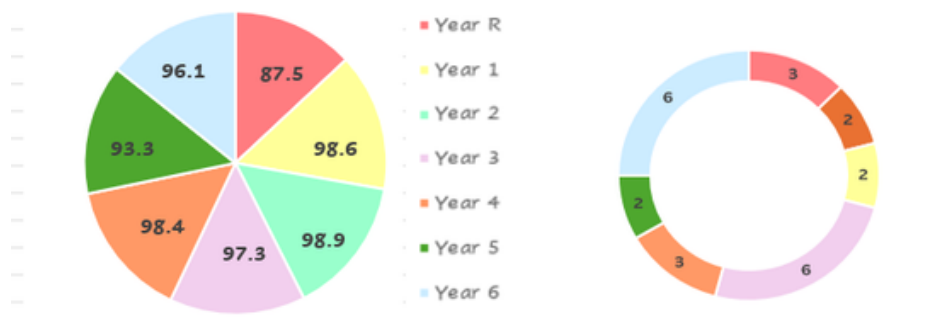
Next week, we are looking forward to welcoming families into school for our Father's Day breakfast.
