


# Buckshaw Primary School

Dear Parents and Carers,

You have been contacted today and confirmed that you wish your child to be in school throughout the current Lockdown. For some your child may well have been in school today. The requirements set out from the Government and our provision in school is different from that of the first Lockdown. However, our commitment to the health, safety and well-being of our whole-school community remains a priority.

A significant difference in the provision for children attending school is that they will be taught in their usual classrooms alongside others from their year groups. They will be receiving the same education as children who are being taught remotely within their own homes. All the precautions set out in our risk assessment from last term will be in place, but there will be significantly less children and reduced number of parents travelling to and from school.

As the children will be following their usual lessons in school, they will be using their books and equipment in school and these will not be able to be taken home. Children will be in the same consistent bubbles within school and using the same designated areas. Therefore, it is considered both safer and more beneficial for those children attending to be in full time. Please support us in this decision.

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

Children should wear full school uniform. We are awaiting a delivery of school fleeces, and your child will receive one free of charge (grant received from Parish Council). In the meantime, if you feel your child needs extra warmth they may wear an additional layer over their school sweatshirt.

## SCHOOL DINNERS

Hot dinners will be provided for children eligible for FSM and for those wishing to buy a school meal. Children may bring in pack lunches as was the situation before Christmas.

## TOAST

Toast will be available and you can pay for this using Scopay as you normally would.

## MILK

Milk will be available for children who would normally receive this. This can be paid for on Scopay.
