## SUN PROTECTION

We have recently developed a sun protection policy to ensure that we can all enjoy the sun safely.

The sun's rays are particularly strong over the summer and they can damage children's skin. This may not seem like a problem right now, but it can lead to skin cancer in later life.

Your child's health and well-being are very important to us, which is why we have decided to:

- Increase the amount of school time spent learning about sun protection.
- Encourage pupils to wear hats when outside.
- Encourage pupils to use at least SPF 25+ sunscreen in summer months.
- Encourage pupils to stay in the shade where possible.

More details of these and other new sun protection plans can be found in our sun protection policy which is available on our website or from the school office.

Your support is very important to us. You can help by:

- Talking to your child about the importance of sun protection at home.
- Sending your child to school with a wide-brimmed hat.
- Sending your child to school with their own bottle of sunscreen that is clearly labelled with their name.
- Ensuring sunscreen has been applied at home before school.
