

# Behaviour

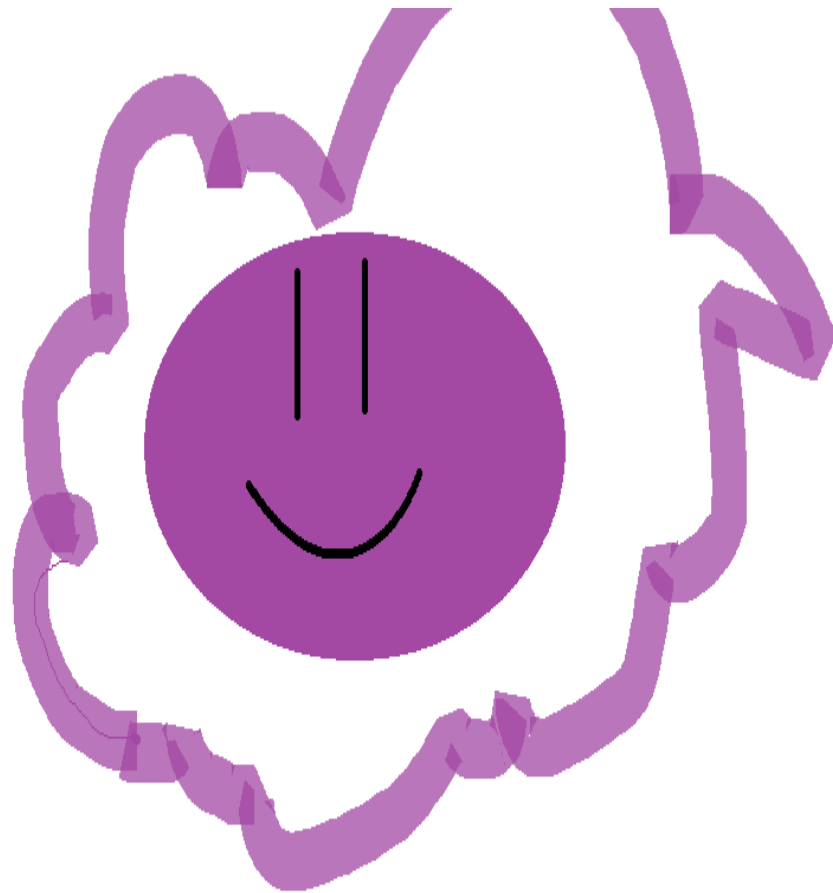
## Policy

Hello!

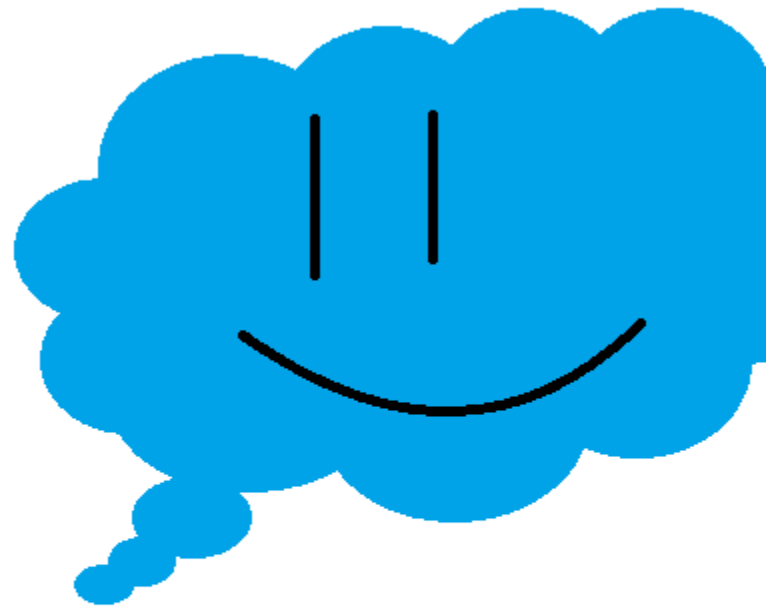
Im sure you are wondering what this is!

This is a traffic light system to show your  
behaviour. If you move up to purple that

means you have been really good and if you stay there for the whole day you get 5 dojos. And if you stay there for the week im sure you'll be dojo champion.



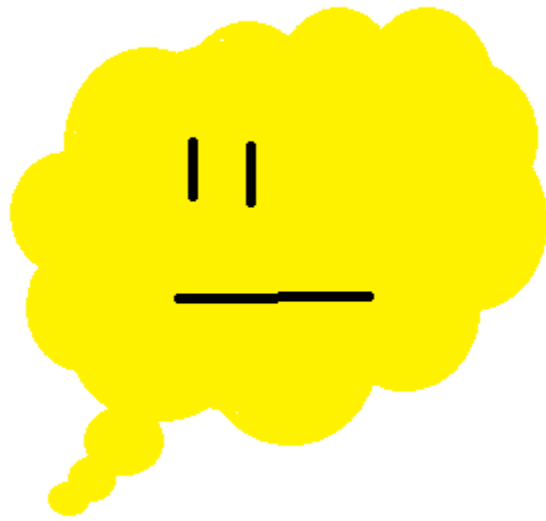
This is the blue section. If you stay here that means you've been good and if you stay here for the whole day you get 3 dojos. If you stay here all week you might be dojo champion and if your very good here you can move up to purple.



Green is the one you start it isn't bad it is good if you stay on here for the entire school day that means you have been good and you get one dojo.



This is yellow which means you get a warning . If you stay all day you don't get any dojos but during the day you have a chance to get back on green.



Orange is not very good this means you stay here no matter what. If you go on orange that means you get an orange card home to your parents and that means they will be disappointed with you. You go here for a serious incident, for example, physical contact and abusive language.
